

DOING BUSINESS



In 2018, the Resolution on the World Bank's Best Practices Implementation, developed by BRDO's experts and allowing Ukraine to gain +4 positions in the rating, was approved.



The comprehensive draft law No.8124 that will have a significant impact on the investment attractiveness of Ukraine was developed by BRDO and registered in the Verkhovna Rada in 2018. It was preceded by a package of draft laws No.6540-6543 registered on 06/06/2017. The approval of these draft laws will allow Ukraine to improve its positions in the **top 40** in the world ranking and attract about **\$10 billion** investments.

REGIONAL DOING BUSINESS

In 2017, BRDO together with the Union of Ukrainian Entrepreneurs (SUP) launched a Regional Doing Business project. The project involves monitoring and analyzing the ease of doing business in the regions and providing recommendations to local authorities.

DEREGULATION: DECISIONS FOR BUSINESS

In 2016-2018, BRDO experts together with relevant ministries developed 8 better regulation packages that improve business environment approved by the Government

The approval of these decisions allowed to:

launch new markets (mobile payments market, etc.)

create new instruments for more transparent activities of government agencies

cancel >1000 outdated and illegal acts

provide annual business savings in the amount of >1 billion hryvnias

DEREGULATION: CASH REGISTERS



Introducing an alternative to cash registers (PCs, tablets, mobile devices).

The CMU Resolution No.472 of 13/06/18 was adopted



Simplifying a procedure for cash register registration in SFS agencies.

Amendments to the Order of the Ministry of Finance No.577 of 14/06/16 were approved



Simplifying maintenance and warranty repair procedures for cash registers.

The CMU Resolution No.601 of 16/05/04 was amended



Cancellation of the daily use of accounting books of settlement operations (abolishment of "gluing in sales receipts").

The Order of the Ministry of Finance No.547 of 14/06/16 was

amended

CONSTRUCTION SECTOR

Institutional reforms were initiated



Reforming the system of technical regulation in construction (Updated State Construction Norms and national standards)



Reforming the rules for introduction of construction products to the market (Implementation of provisions of the Regulation (EU) No 305/2011)

System regulatory changes were introduced

Authorization-based procedures for construction with deviations from State Construction Norms were optimized

Time limits of construction licenses were cancelled

Improved application of Eurocodes in design of CC3 class construction objects

The issues of free access to urban planning documentation and an optimized procedure of cadastral registrars' activity were resolved

A legal framework was prepared for the implementation of online "private cabinets" for developers in the "Transparent DABI" system was initiated

Public access to urban planning documentation was introduced

The obligation of central and local authorities to provide access to open data of urban planning documentation via geoinformational portals was established at the legislative level

The index of public disclosure of urban planning documentation (+16% in 2018) increased as a result of the PMAP project implementation

A unified PMAP.MINREGION.GOV.UA web resource was launched to publish urban planning documents

IT SECTOR



In 2017, 2 main barriers to creating a new mobile payments market were cancelled. After that, 2 operators started launching new services



The compulsory registration of sanitary certificates for mobile base stations and construction declarations for those ones located on existing buildings was cancelled. This reduced the abuse of control authorities and led to business savings in the amount of **100 million hryvnias** per year



The rules and methods to access infrastructure facilities were adopted, and this gave impetus to the broadband access development in Ukraine



The employment of CIS citizens in Ukraine was simplified – from now on, they are not obliged to leave the territory of Ukraine due to bureaucratic procedures



A concept of state policy for virtual currencies (cryptocurrencies) was developed

AGRICULTURE SECTOR

Institutional reforms were implemented



The Ukrainian Organic Standard was created (EU Regulation 834/2007; 889/2008; 1235/2008)



The monopoly to conduct phytosanitary examination by state laboratories was cancelled (EU Directive 2000/29; Regulation 2016/2031; 685/2017)



Institutional reforms were initiated

Forestry reform:

- electronic timber trade (EU Regulation 995/2010)
- a plan for support of forest management measures (Presidential Decree 381/2017)

Beekeeping industry reform:

- a concept of industry reform was developed
- a procedure for registration of about 400 thousand beekeepers was simplified
- honey quality requirements were prepared according to EU standards (Directive 2001/110)

Simplifying doing business



The ban to mix different grain types was lifted. Economic effect for business – **2.7 billion hryvnias** of savings and **7%** increase in logistics efficiency

The process of connection to electricity networks in accordance with the rules defined by the Law of Ukraine "On Electricity Market" and the Distribution System Code was unblocked, and this will eventually allow to transparently plan connection costs for businesses in advance

A Concept for development of the market of electric charging stations was developed



A package of regulatory changes regarding the following aspects was developed:


- the introduction of electronic procedures for conducting subsoil rights auctions;
- the transparency of initial pricing for special permits;
- the simplification of a procedure for holding tenders for special permits;
- the exclusion of the possibility of overlapping different subsoil access instruments: special permits and signing of production sharing agreements;
- the optimization of procedures of cooperation between the State Service of Geology and Subsoil and market participants and the digitization of geoinformation.

MARKET SURVEILLANCE

Creating efficient business rules:



3 legal acts aimed at simplifying the business environment in special water use, geological examination and registration of settlement operations were adopted. The economic effect – **300 billion hryvnias** of savings for businesses



Methodological recommendations for the efficient selection of instruments and procedures aimed at reducing administrative pressure on business and competent state management were developed in 4 areas of state regulation:

- Methodology of the applicability of market access instruments.
- Model of "price control".
- Methodology of the compulsory insurance applicability.
- Methodology of the applicability of instruments for access to shared limited resources.

Results of state regulation methods Rolling Review:

WE DEVELOPED:

2 draft laws aimed at improving licensing procedures and reducing types of licensed business activities

9 legal acts, which propose to cancel **313** acts and revise **8** acts regarding price regulation, cash registers, licensing, system of permits and others

A Concept of creating an efficient system for ensuring price stability

THE GOVERNMENT APPROVED:

Amendments to the CMU Resolution No.1548 dated December 25, 1996 "On Establishment of Competences of Government Executive Bodies and Executive Bodies of City Councils Regarding Prices (Tariffs) Regulation", which cancelled price regulation in 8 areas. The economic effect of the adopted act for businesses is 6.5 million hryvnias and for the state – 18.5 million hryvnias

10 acts, which cancelled **361** acts and proposed to revise **20** acts, in particular, in the following areas:

- licensing,
- licensing system
- labor protection (the State Labor Service's monopoly to define expert organizations was removed, and this simplifies technical inspection procedures for businesses),
- simplification of the procedure of employment/stay of foreigners in Ukraine and simplification of the procedure for setting up foreign organizations in Ukraine;
- cash registers(simplifying the procedure for using cash registers)

INFRASTRUCTURE SECTOR



An analytical platform for monitoring the use of funds of the Road Fund was developed



The adoption of
State Environmental

A reform of the interregional bus transportation market was initiated (the Government approved amendments to the Resolution No. 1081 developed jointly with BRDO experts)



EUROINTEGRATION

14 draft legal acts European integration obligations compliance checks were prepared

A package of legal acts for the implementation of European integration obligations in agriculture (organic production, phytosanitary examination) was adopted

Instruments for additional consumer protection under timeshare contracts were developed (implementation of the Directive 2008/122/EU)

A Concept of improving the legislative decision procedure in European integration was developed

A new version of the draft law introducing provisions of the Regulation (EU) No 305/2011 was developed

BRDO experts participated in drafting the Law "On Principles of State Policy in European Integration"

Technical regulations on gaseous fuel devices and pressure mobile equipment, on limitation of the use of hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment and on implementation of European integration obligations developed by BRDO were adopted
