When the full-scale Russian invasion of Ukraine began, we all had to review our professional activities. Developing policies, drafting laws, and working on digital business solutions seemed initially invalid. However, with time it became evident that our reforms and initiatives maintained their relevance, and new challenges faced by Ukraine today amid the war, force us to open a new area of activity — the military one. To simplify the import of UAVs and other military goods, to provide evacuation of state registers, to launch a nationwide "Shelter" portal, to create a new register of damaged and destroyed property, to help businesses with wartime adaptation, and to prepare for future reconstruction of Ukraine — we added these tasks to the BRDO agenda. Most importantly, Ukrainian institutions keep working and proving their resilience daily, and we cooperate with the state to guarantee its continuous development.
